King William's College – Taxi Policy

This policy relates to the use of taxis by students of King William's College (“the College”)

1. Taxis are booked from time to time for use by students, mainly College boarders, either by the boarders themselves, or by College staff on their behalf. The most common situation is for trips to and from the airport when dedicated school transport is not available.
2. The College can recommend one or more taxi firms, from whom written confirmation has been received that drivers have undergone adequate Police checks.
3. The names of these recommended taxi firms (which may change from time to time) can be obtained from the Chief Operating Officer or the Head of Boarding, and they will be made generally available to all students.
4. Students are also free to use other taxi firms, if they choose to do so, with their parents' consent.
5. Students are also free to use other forms public transport such as bus, steam train or tram.
